Initiatives under her supervision include United Way's family savings program, *Saving for the American Dream*, the Asset Building Coalition, and the Los Angeles Earned Income Tax Credit Campaign which brought back more than \$13.5 million in EITC and more than \$36 million in total refund dollars this past year.

Marguerite also chairs the Los Angeles Workforce Funder Collaborative. This partnership is comprised of foundations, corporations, and public entities with unique funding priorities and a shared vision to skill-up the workforce and aligns workforce systems.

Marguerite serves her community both through her work and through her volunteer activities including the Asian Rehabilitation Services Board of Directors, the California Community Colleges Economic & Workforce Development Program Advisory Committee, and as a judge for the California Award for Performance Excellence.
