2010 Chamber-Sponsored Legislation

K-12 Public Education

- **AB 1223 (Block) Linked Learning** – encourages the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing to form a work group for the purposes of defining linked learning “recognition of study” to support teacher knowledge, development and implementation of applied learning strategies in the classroom, which is critical to student success and retention.

- **AB 2211 (Fuentes) Work-based Learning** – would expand quality work-based learning programs for students by encouraging school districts and employers to create work experience programs that reinforce academic learning.

Community College

- **SB 1143 (Liu) Community College Funding** – establish a framework for allocating state funds to community colleges in a manner that provides incentives for community colleges to assist students in completing coursework in which they enroll and coursework that is required to earn a certificate or degree
