WORLD TRADE WEEK 2014 COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

The World Trade Week 2014 Education Committee is sponsoring several \$1000 scholarships for students intending to pursue a career in international trade. The qualifications include:

1. **Full-time Student**: A candidate must be enrolled in a full-time academic program relating to international trade with verification of a min. 2.75 GPA. If a student's major does not have an international dimension, an international trade internship will suffice.
2. **Internship Report (one to two pages)**: Essay should detail the candidate's demonstrated commitment to a career related to international trade and/or global business through an internship related to these fields. The internship report should include the name of the company, explain the international aspect of their business, along with a description of activities as an intern.
3. **Letter of Recommendation**: Two Letters of Recommendation, one of the letters must from the faculty member.
4. **Future Mentor**: A candidate must be willing to become a future international trade mentor to other students once he or she has become an international business professional

The purpose of the scholarships is to foster international trade education and international business development.

The deadline for submission and receipt of the materials described above is **5 p.m., Friday, March 28, 2014**. Submitted materials will be reviewed and winners notified by mid-April. The scholarship recipients will be awarded at the annual Kickoff-off Breakfast in downtown Los Angeles. Winners must be present to accept the award and provide proof of enrollment in applicable classes at a valid university or college in order to receive the scholarship check.

1. Complete an internship in an international trade-related field.
2. Write a one-two page internship report.
3. Request letters of recommendation.
4. Provide transcripts
5. Submit the internship report, letter of recommendation, and a copy of your resume to the following:
