## At the Crossroads of Cultures & Trade

Last year we focused on the power to access global markets utilizing the plentiful trade resources which are right here in the Los Angeles area. This year we shift our focus to an even more fundamental contributor to this region's considerable economic strength — its diversity. Los Angeles is a polycultural

trade junction where significant trade routes intersect and the city is a cultural melting pot unlike any other place in the world.

Perhaps iconic of the promise of these diverse ties to so many places around the world are 93 Sister City relationships between cities in the Los Angeles area and cities like Nagoya, Japan; Mexico City, Mexico; and Berlin, Germany; which allow us to learn more about one another and to develop friendly meaningful exchanges. This unique intersection we call Los Angeles serves as a meeting place between people of diverse cultural backgrounds and an incubator for their economic ties.

In 2007, the value of two-way trade between China and the Los Angeles Customs District reached \$183 billion. Japan was Los Angeles' second-largest trading partner, with total two-way trade valued at \$60.5 billion, and South Korea came in a close third with \$24.6 billion. Additionally, more than 500,000 jobs in Los Angeles County are directly tied to international trade. This sector remains the largest employer of the local economy.

While many of us tend to think in terms of importing foreign-made goods, businesses in the greater Los Angeles area are pioneers in 21st century industries such as aerospace and defense, healthcare technologies, entertainment, green technologies, clean energy and goods movement, to name a few. Products and services from these sectors are highly demanded by customers not only in the United States but around the world and will continue to offer significant export opportunities.

No matter how you got to these crossroads, you have a unique opportunity to benefit from Los Angeles' cultural bounty and the trade opportunities presented by its diversity. Please utilize World Trade Week 2009 as a time to reflect on how to open this door to the world.

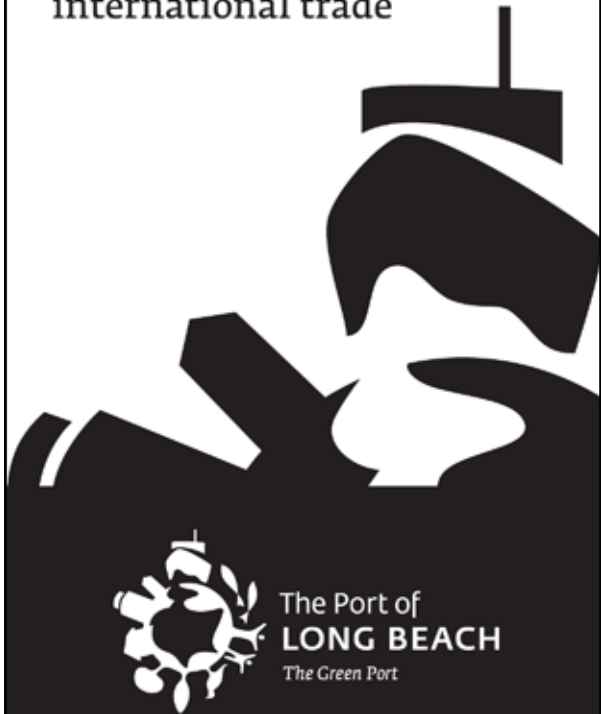

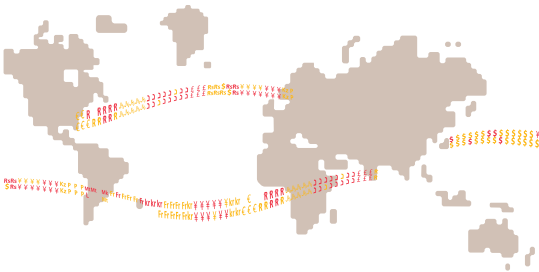

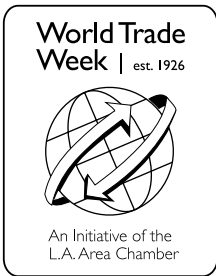

## World Trade Week History



The World Trade Week concept was started in 1926 and first observed in 1927 in Southern California. World trade significantly contributes to the nation's economy and has developed a vast new horizon for America's businesses.

In 1926, Stanley T. Olafson, then manager of the World Trade Department of the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce, conceived the idea of a World Trade Week observance in Southern California. This was during a period of isolationism and under the conditions prevailing during the heyday of the restrictive Smoot-Hawley Tariff Act.

In 1935, President Franklin Delano Roosevelt officially proclaimed World Trade Week as a national observance by the U.S. Government and selected the third week in May each year which includes May 22, National Maritime Day.

Initially, the purpose of World Trade Week was the promotion of the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach. Following World War II, the expanding economy and potential for international commerce growth created an opportunity for World Trade Week to expand its scope to include all facilities and organizations in the Southern California area involved in world trade.

Under the guidance of its founding sponsors the Los Angeles Area Chamber of Commerce, Los Angeles World Airports, The Port of Long Beach and The Port of Los Angeles, the original weeklong observance has grown to more than 30 events held each year throughout the month of May in the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego and Ventura.

This tremendous nonprofit endeavor is further supported by Southern California companies that offer sponsorship for the many programs and informational materials the World Trade Week Southern California Committee creates each year.

**Education has been a focus of World Trade Week Southern California in recent years. Some current programs and involvement include:**

### **SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS**

The World Trade Week Committee makes available grants to educators who will implement an international trade related curriculum in their classroom. This allows students to become involved in the countless opportunities of international trade at an early age.

The World Trade Week Committee also offers scholarships to aspiring students in the international trade fields. Scholarships are awarded to outstanding graduating high school seniors entering an accredited college or university with the goal to prepare for a profession in international trade.

At the university level, scholarships are awarded to full-time students that have completed or are in the process of completing at least a quarter or semester internship with an international business, organization, or association of the Los Angeles international trade community.

The purpose of the scholarships is to foster international trade education and international business development. In establishing this scholarship program, the Committee hopes to develop a network of international trade professionals who would be willing to provide mentoring to future students wanting to enter the field of international business.

### **INFORMATIONAL BRIEFINGS**

The World Trade Week committee hosts several educational briefings a year, focused on educating high school students, educators and career counselors on career opportunities in fields related to international trade.

*International Careers: A Roadmap to Success* features specific international career profiles from the public and private sectors, including banking, consulting, education, logistics, marketing and trade policy promotion.

- ▶ The Los Angeles-Long Beach-Santa Ana region represents 38 percent of California's exports and ranks as the third-largest metro area exporter nationally.
- ▶ There are over 261,000 jobs in Los Angeles County directly linked to trade.
- ▶ The combined ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach are the fifth busiest in the world and the busiest in North America, handling nearly one-third of all U.S. trade.
- ▶ The Los Angeles Customs district was the first ever to surpass \$300 billion in annual trade. The value of two-way trade passing through Los Angeles totaled \$349.4 billion in 2007.

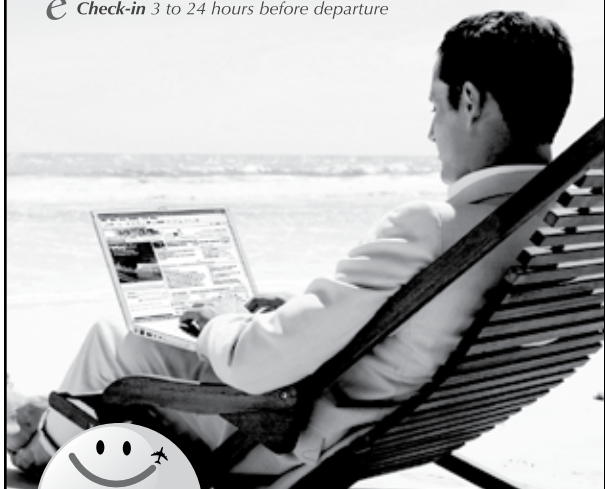

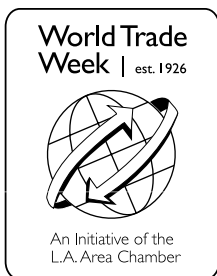

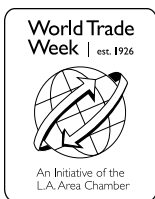
