## World Trade: The Path to Economic Recovery

In early 2009, people all around the world witnessed a historic moment as President Barack Obama was sworn in as America's 44th President. Among many challenges that the Obama Administration inherited was this nation's economic crisis.

Last year was a tough year as we all continued to experience crises in the financial market, an alarming rise in unemployment, and negative or stalled economic growth throughout the world. International trade is not immune to the global recession — import growth is slowing, and exports were declining in 2009 after several years of exceptional growth. But that picture is slowly improving.

During his inaugural speech President Obama vowed to begin the work of "remaking America," and during his first address to the nation before a joint session of Congress in January 2010, stated that "we will double our exports over the next five years, an increase that will support two million jobs in America." These objectives are key components of our economic recovery, and the genesis for the World Trade Week 2010 theme — "World Trade: The Path to Economic Recovery."

Last year, major adjustments were made by households, and business and financial institutions to reduce debts and rebuild their balance sheets. These adjustments were necessary to survive the economic hardships and lay the foundation for our nation's future growth. U.S. international trade policy shifted its emphasis to restoring balanced growth between imports and exports. Although both exports and imports declined in 2009, the decline in imports easily outpaced that of exports as our country's appetite for imports weakened. With domestic demand unlikely to turn upward significantly for the coming years, exports must be part of our growth strategy.

The economic rebound in key trade partnering regions of California, such as the Pacific Rim, Latin America and the Canadian economies, signals demands for our products and services.

Given the dynamics of world trade, the present global recession will only be cured by solutions that are beneficial to all nations. If 2009 was a year of rebuilding, 2010 will be a challenging year of laying the foundation to sustainable growth. We need to focus on creating stable, cooperative and positive relationships with our trading partners — key relationships that are not only mutually beneficial, but are also partnerships that benefit the entire world.

I am honored to serve as the Chair for World Trade Week 2010. I commend the World Trade Week committee members for their tireless efforts, and I also want to thank the many participating organizations and sponsors of World Trade Week and the international trade community for their continued support and commitment. Please join me in helping to make 2010 a great year for world trade!

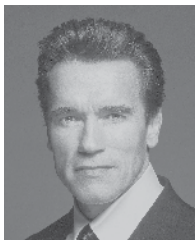

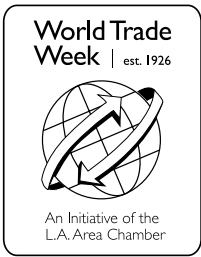

## World Trade Week History



Celebrating a month of world trade in May

®

The World Trade Week concept was conceived in 1926 and first observed in 1927 in Southern California. World trade significantly contributes to the nation's economy and has developed a vast new horizon for America's businesses.

In 1926, Stanley T. Olafson, then manager of the World Trade Department of the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce, conceived the idea of a World Trade Week observance in Southern California.

This was during a period of isolationism and under the conditions prevailing during the heyday of the restrictive Smoot-Hawley Tariff Act.

In 1935, President Franklin Delano Roosevelt officially proclaimed World Trade Week as a national observance by the U.S. Government and selected the third week in May each year which includes May 22, National Maritime Day.



Initially, the purpose of World Trade Week was the promotion of the ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach. Following World War II, the expanding economy and potential for international commerce growth created an opportunity for World Trade Week to expand its scope to include all facilities and organizations in the Southern California area involved in world trade.

Under the guidance of its founding sponsors the Los Angeles Area Chamber of Commerce, Los Angeles World Airports, The Port of Long Beach and The Port of Los Angeles, the original week-long observance has now grown to more than 30 events held throughout May each year in the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego and Ventura.

This tremendous nonprofit endeavor is further supported by Southern California companies who offer sponsorship for the many programs and informational materials the World Trade Week Southern California Committee creates each year.

## LOS ANGELES COUNTY TRADE STATISTICS

---

- ▶ The Los Angeles-Long Beach-Santa Ana region represents 38 percent of California's exports and ranks as the third-largest metro area exporter nationally.
- ▶ There are more than 496,000 jobs in Los Angeles County directly linked to trade.
- ▶ The combined ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach are the fifth busiest in the world and the busiest in North America, handling nearly one-third of all U.S. trade.
- ▶ The Los Angeles Customs District was the first ever to surpass \$300 billion in annual trade. The value of two-way trade passing through Los Angeles totaled \$357.3 billion in 2008.
- ▶ The top export commodities out of the Los Angeles Customs District are computers, peripherals, machinery and appliances and parts with a total value of \$17.3 billion.
- ▶ L.A.'s top two-way trade partners include China, Japan, South Korea, Taiwan and Thailand. China accounts for a two-way trade value of about \$186.6 billion.

### **SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS**

The World Trade Week Committee makes grants available to educators who will implement an international trade related curriculum in their classroom. This allows students to become involved in the countless opportunities of international trade at an early age.

The World Trade Week Committee also offers scholarships to aspiring students in the international trade fields. Scholarships are awarded to outstanding graduating high school seniors entering an accredited college or university with the goal to prepare for a profession in international trade.

At the university level, scholarships are awarded to full time students who have completed, or are in the process of completing, at least a quarter or semester internship with an international business, organization, or association of the Los Angeles international trade community.

The purpose of the scholarships is to foster international trade education and international business development. In establishing this scholarship program, the Committee hopes to develop a network of international trade professionals who would be willing to provide mentoring to future students wanting to enter the field of international business.

### **INFORMATIONAL BRIEFINGS**

The World Trade Week Committee hosts several educational briefings a year, focused on educating high school students, educators and career counselors on career opportunities in fields related to international trade.


