Herb Schultz serves as senior health policy advisor to the Governor. Most recently, he has served as Vice President of Government Programs for McKesson Health Solutions, where he oversaw the company's disease management and nurse advice programs for Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries.

Schultz previously was Acting Director of the California Employment Development Department in the first year of Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger's Administration. He served as a member of then-Governor Gray Davis' Cabinet as Acting Secretary for the Labor and Workforce Development Agency.

Schultz was appointed Undersecretary before his Cabinet-Level appointment, and remained in both roles until the end of the Davis Administration. Prior to that, he was Deputy Director of External Affairs for the Department of Managed Health Care, which including serving as Director of the Advisory Committee on Managed Health Care.

Schultz went to college and graduate school in Washington, DC, having received his Undergraduate Degree in Political Science from The American University and has a Masters Degree in Public Policy from Georgetown University.
