Kristen Monaco is Professor of Economics and Associate Director of the Master's program in Global Logistics at California State University Long Beach. She received her PhD in Economics from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 1998 and joined the faculty of CSULB in 2001.

Her research is focused on the relationship between market structure and labor outcomes, with a focus on the trucking industry. She has published articles relating to this topic in *Industrial and Labor Relations Review*, *Review of Industrial Organization*, *Research in Transport Economics*, *Journal of the Transportation Research Forum* and *Journal of Transportation and Statistics*.

Her current research focuses on the labor markets involved in goods movement at the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach. In addition, she is an affiliated consultant with Beacon Economics and is currently involved with the economic analysis of the Port of Oakland's Comprehensive Truck Maintenance Program.
