### Governor agrees to lead Chamber-sponsored redistricting reform initiative

Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger announced Monday that he supports and intends to lead the effort to qualify a redistricting reform initiative for the November 2008 ballot. The Voters First Act, proposed by the Chamber, AARP, California Common Cause, and the League of California Women Voters, would create a 14-person independent citizens commission to draw district boundaries for the State Senate, State Assembly and Board of Equalization. Doing so would end the inherent conflict of interest that allows lawmakers to gerrymander their own districts. The initiative was filed with the Attorney General's office on Oct. 23, and signature gathering efforts will begin within the next few weeks.
